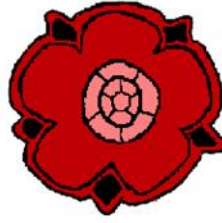

Anti-Bullying Week 2010 on 15-19 November

Anti-Bullying Weeks sends a clear and positive message that bullying is neither acceptable or inevitable in our schools and communities. Anti-Bullying Week 2010 will take place from 15-19 November. This year we are looking at the importance of **Taking action together.**

This year, Anti-Bullying Week looks at bystanders; those who witness bullying and don't tell anyone or take action to stop it. Those who turn a blind eye to bullying or don't do something to stop it.

Bullying will only stop if we all take action together.

Taking action to stop bullying

Bullying will only stop if we take action together but we know that significant numbers of children and young people who witness bullying still don't tell anyone or take action to stop it. It might also be parents and carers, other adults and schools and communities who turn a blind eye or don't take action to stop bullying.

Book bags (£3.50) and swim bags (£3) are available from the school office.

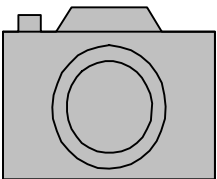

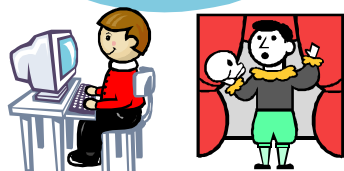
